Different journeys, one shared canvas of creativity:

From London to Jakarta to Papan, the Kita Orang: Blue & White 400 exhibition has sparked a wave of artistic connection. In London, England, three artists - Cinzia Ciaramicoli, Lara López Ayuso and Mindy Qin - explored the Wanli Shipwreck through experimentation and storytelling. In Jakarta, Indonesian artists gathered to paint in unity. Closer to home, in Papan, Perak, retired villagers made their mark by creating a fingerprint Tree of Life together.











A Dance Between Artists and the Blue-and-White Glaze

Never doubt the perseverance of an artist, for it can give rise to infinite possibilities. Thank you, Alice, whose passion for art and the timeless charm of blue-and-white porcelain brought everyone together. For artists from all over the world, this Kita Orang: Blue & White International Group Exhibition, has become a platform for exchange and mutual learning.

The once-slumbering blue-and-white porcelain has been revived through the hands of painters, like a dialogue that transcends time and space, a true embodiment of Silk Road civilisation. In this series of exhibited works, artists from diverse backgrounds reinterpret the romance and elegance of blue-and-white porcelain through their unique styles and techniques. Through masterful brushstrokes, the interplay of blue and white unfolds with rhythmic balance, like the reserved blank spaces of ink and watercolour paintings, evoking the flow of air and the space to breathe. This is where the artist's ingenuity shines.

True artistic elegance lies in understanding that silence can speak louder than declarations.

This cross-border, cross-cultural invitation in blue and white is a shared dance that speaks of eternal creation, a dialogue of civilisations and a legacy of spirit. Each participating artist has felt the warmth of history; in their works, the ancient meets the contemporary, and the light of different cultures weaves together. What we witness is not just a piece of art, but a soul resonating with beauty.

Ultimately, through the audience's appreciation and reflection, beauty is expressed, an expression in the shared language of humanity. And creation, above all, is the artist's calling.



Calvin Chua

Calvin Chua, co-curator of Kita Orang: Blue & White International Group Exhibition, is a veteran Malaysian artist and Chairman of the Malaysian Watercolour Society, with a decades-long international career in painting.

Melalui sapuan berus yang mahir, interaksi biru dan putih terungkap dengan keseimbangan berirama, seperti ruang kosong yang terpelihara dalam lukisan dakwat dan cat air, membangkitkan aliran udara dan ruang untuk bernafas. Di sinilah kepintaran seniman menyerlah.

The timeless beauty of blue-and-white porcelain — with its delicate cobalt designs on whiteclay — is the heart of this exhibition. Those Ming-era pieces weren't just beautiful; they also symbolised centuries of trade, cultural exchange, and the incredible skill of craftsmen.

Even today, blue and white remains a favourite with artists everywhere because of its elegance, simplicity,

and ability to tell stories across generations. This exhibition honours both the history behind these colours and the fresh, modern ways artists interpret them now.

When Lai Lai Art put out the call for entries, the response was overwhelming — over 400 submissions from all over the world! From Malaysia to our neighbours in Indonesia, the Philippines, South Korea, Singapore and Thailand, and as far as India, France, and the UK — artists embraced the theme and let their creativity shine.

On display are 1ft x 1ft artworks in every imaginable style — from traditional paintings on rice paper to mixed media and even digital art. Together, they show just how far the story of blue and white has travelled, and how many different ways it can inspire.

What truly makes Kita Orang: Blue & White 400 special is the incredible mix of people taking part. Here you'll find work by professional artists alongside pieces by children as young as six, retirees sharing decades of wisdom through their art, and individuals with special needs expressing themselves in ways that move and inspire.

Art is for everyone — and this exhibition proves it. Every single canvas has a story to tell, whether it's thoughtful, playful, nostalgic, or bold.

A Truly Malaysian Celebration

Happening in Kuala Lumpur this September, then travelling up north to Penang, and to the east, to Kuching, Sarawak, the exhibition promises to be a feast for the eyes and a celebration of creativity without boundaries.




Margaret Ng Lee Ee • Shah Alam, Selangor, Malaysia












Study In Cobalt And UltramarineOil on Canvas

In the Depth Of The Blue Dynasty Acrylic 2025

This abstract, symbolic work reimagines both the recovered and lost pieces of the Wanli shipwreck, weaving a magical and romantic narrative of discovery. A graceful ceramic form emerges from the depths, accompanied by fish — the spirit of the porcelain — adding majesty and evoking the sea's movement. The female figure embodies the ceramics' delicacy and fragility, while transparent layers and fine brushstrokes invite viewers to linger on the shifting blues and exquisite details.

Nine Grid Of Smiles Acrylic 2025

Rendered in Phthalo Blue acrylic on white canvas, this work presents nine smiling faces – diverse in age, gender and culture – arranged in a classic nine-grid format. Like windows side by side, each frame holds its own quiet story, yet all are linked by a fine white line, a subtle thread of connection. The blue shifts in depth and clarity, allowing each smile to emerge with both presence and delicacy, whispering to its neighbors in a silent choreography of humanity's gentlest language. A smile needs no translation. Art knows no borders. Connection begins in the act of seeing.


